SEVEN MARY THREE TO ROCK AT PRIVATE HIGH SCHOOL SHOW
Contest Brings National Recording Act to Blanchet High School

Portland, OR—For a little while on November 18, a Seattle high school will enjoy the unlikely spotlight of musical stardom when a nationally-known alternative rock band, Seven Mary Three, gives the school its own private, intimate, acoustic performance.

The event is a result of a contest held by Nordstrom, alternative radio station The End and footwear and apparel manufacturer Dr. Martens. Young Nordstrom customers were invited to enter a drawing to have acclaimed recording artists Seven Mary Three play a free concert at their high school. The lucky winner was Sarah Dean, a senior at Blanchet High School. Her name was drawn from over 3,000 entries and entitles her to a new outfit from Dr. Martens, a backstage visit with the band and a moment of fame when she introduces the band to her classmates at the concert.

Seven Mary Three are currently touring in support of their new album, *RockCrown*. Their 1995 major label debut, *American Standard*, hit platinum last year and climbed to #1 on the *Billboard* chart.
